Discovered in 1492, and populated with African slaves, Haiti is now the poorest and most densely populated country in the western hemisphere. Located in the eastern Caribbean, Haiti shares an island with the Dominican Re-



public, a vastly different country socio-economically.

Here are a few facts about Haiti:

- Area:** 10,700,000 sq mi
- Population:** est 8 million
- Official Languages:** French, Creole
- Literacy:** 45%
- Life Expectancy:** 52
- Unemployment Rate:** 80%
- GDP (2000):** \$1,340 USD

Current Environmental Issues: extensive deforestation (much of the remaining forested land is being cleared for agriculture and used as fuel); soil erosion; inadequate supplies of potable water.
